## Purpose:

This agreement aims to establish a collaboration to prepare students in Greece for careers in open-source technologies and improve the job prospects and employability of students by integrating curriculum and certification in Linux and open source software.

## **Agreement Points:**

### **Certification and Workforce Preparation of Students:**

- 1. Implement certification programs in open-source technologies for school and university students.
- 2. Develop specialized courses and workshops covering various areas of open-source technologies.
- 3. Establish a network of educational institutions to facilitate access to these certification programs.

# **Promotion of the Open-Source Software Industry:**

- 1. Create a framework for developing the open-source software industry, focusing on the digital transformation of public and private organizations.
- 2. Facilitate the formation of consortia and alliances between open-source software companies and government entities.
- 3. Promote the adoption of open-source solutions in local and national digital transformation projects.
- 4. Establish training and certification programs for professionals in open-source technologies, ensuring a qualified workforce.

#### **Commitment and Collaboration:**

- Both parties commit to sharing resources, knowledge, and experiences to achieve the agreement's objectives.
- A follow-up committee with representatives from both organizations will be established to monitor progress and ensure the objectives are met.
- Periodic meetings will be held to evaluate progress, discuss challenges, and adjust strategies as needed.

### **Duration and Renewal:**

Linux Professional Institute

- This agreement will have an initial duration of 4 years, with the possibility of renewal for additional periods by mutual agreement.
- Either party may propose modifications to the agreement, which must be approved by both parties in writing.

## **Final Clauses:**

- This agreement does not constitute a financial obligation for either party unless specified in future specific agreements.
- Any disputes arising from this agreement will be resolved amicably through negotiations between the parties.
